



CUTLERY, 48 PIECES. PARIS, 1819 - 1838 AND MUNICH, 19TH CENTURY, LOUIS WOLLENWEBER | SILVER, GILDED.

Paris, 1819 - 1838 and Munich, 19th century, Louis Wollenweber | Silver, gilded.

Marks: BZ, 14, MZ: "Louis Wollenweber".

French hallmarks partly illegible.

Length: 14 cm to 18.5 cm. Total weight: 1,740 g.

Knives total weight 515 g (handles weighted).

Pattern: Augsburg thread. Crowned monogram engraving "M," likely for Marie Elisabeth Amalie Franziska in Bavaria (1784 Landshut - 1849 Paris), who became Princess Wagram and Duchess of Neuchâtel by marriage.

48 pieces: twelve knives, twelve forks, twelve spoons, and twelve coffee spoons. In box.

Provenance: from the estate of the Dukes in Bavaria.
