Detailed Description

Beaker, silver-partially gilt

Slightly conical shape. Between the smooth edge zones, the wall is finely punched in a fish or snakeskin pattern.

On the bottom Saxon thaler for Johann, Georg, Duke of Saxony, dated 1629. On the edge of the lip "AW" under crown
